

ACTIVITY 6: ESTIMATE THE NUMBER OF LEGO

Overview

- i. The competitor must estimate the amount of Lego pieces in a pile.
- ii. The competitor may interact with the Lego in any manner of their choosing for the 10 minutes time limit.
- iii. The competitor with the closest estimate to the correct amount of Lego will be allocated 10 points.

Instructions

- i. The answer sheet, pen and the Legos are placed on a tarp in the activity area.
- ii. Once the bell is rung, the competitors may interact with the Lego in any manner they see fit So long as all pieces remain on the tarp.
- iii. Before the 10 minute time limit elapses, the competitor must clearly and legibly write their estimate on the answer sheet.
- iv. When the bell is rung a second time the activity is over. The competitor must hand their answer sheet to the Activity Adjudicator.
- v. After providing the estimate to the Activity Adjudicator, both the competitor and the Adjudicator will work together to re-pile the Legos back into the center of the tarp.

Scoring

- i. Competitors receive points by estimating as close as possible to the correct amount of Lego pieces.
- ii. The competitor with the closest estimate will be allocated 10 points.

- Tarp
- Answer sheet
